Pets bring out the best in us and encourage us to relax and enjoy the simple life, so it makes sense that you would want them to join you on your holiday – they are a furry family member after all!

Shoalhaven off-leash areas include beaches, parks, rivers and trails and dog parks, all of which are perfect for running or relaxing. Great for both dogs and their families to gain an enjoyable form of exercise whilst making new doggie (and human) friends.

If your pet needs to stay somewhere else, consider dog and cat boarding kennels where they can enjoy their own relaxed getaway – and you can pop in and give them lots of cuddles so they don't miss out on all the fun.

Pets on the Move

When you're on the road, ensuring your pet has plenty of water, sufficient breaks for relief, and a bit of reprieve is a must.

Pet Suitcase Checklist:

- ✓ Flea and tick protection - Australian paralysis tick is common, especially in bush areas in the warmer months, so prevention and thoroughly checking your pet is a must
- ✓ Tick remover
- ✓ Bowls for food and water – carry a bottle of water in case you can't find a tap
- ✓ Regular food and some treats
- ✓ A 'pooper scooper' and plastic bags to clean up after your pet
- ✓ A litter tray, waterproof sheet, paper towels and disinfectant
- ✓ Any required medications
- ✓ Collars, harnesses and leads
- ✓ ID tag with your mobile number
- ✓ Bedding or travel crate to sleep in
- ✓ Your pet's favourite toys or comfort items
- ✓ Grooming equipment and towels
- ✓ A pet first aid kit
- ✓ Emergency numbers such as poison hotline & nearest vet
- ✓ Your pet's microchip number in case your dog or cat goes missing
- ✓ Pet insurance papers
- ✓ Scratching post for cats

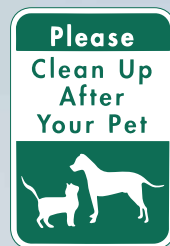
Avoid giving big meals before a long journey as some pets may suffer from travel sickness.

Cats and small dogs should be transported in a carrier & secured with a seatbelt. Bigger dogs should wear a harness.

Keep dogs on a leash when they are outdoors. Cats who are easily spooked should be kept indoors.

Make sure your pet has adequate ventilation and never leave them in a hot car.

Please be aware that it is the responsibility of the pet owner to comply with the off-leash boundaries and off-leash times in the Shoalhaven, as penalties apply for non-compliance. Restriction Guidelines

Dogs in the Shoalhaven are required to be 'on-leash' at all times EXCEPT when in an off-leash area.

Dogs are **totally prohibited** from entering the following areas across the Shoalhaven, whether or not they are otherwise leashed or controlled:

- **Children's play areas** (within 10 metres of any playing apparatus provided in that public place or part for the use of children)
- **Food preparation/consumption areas** (within 10 metres of any apparatus provided in that public place or part for the preparation and consumption of food for human consumption)
- **Recreation areas where dogs are prohibited**
- **Public bathing areas where dogs are prohibited** (including a beach)
- **School grounds** (other than any property used for a residence or the curtilage of a residence)
- **Child care centres** (other than any property used for a residence or the curtilage of a residence)
- **Shopping areas where dogs are prohibited**
- **Wildlife protection areas**

Sharing the Shore

Did you know that beach nesting birds are some of the most threatened in the world? By simply following a few guidelines with your pet you can have a huge impact on their survival. You and your pet can help by:

- Sharing the shoreline by respecting 'Dog Prohibited' beach zones. These areas are designated as prohibited because vulnerable shorebirds nest here between August and April each year.
- Making use of Council's numerous Dog Off Leash beaches, specially designated for off leash fun!
- Keeping your dog on a leash on permitted beaches. Beach nesting birds & chicks perceive unleashed dogs as a great threat. Even if your dog isn't the type to chase, the birds don't know that!
- Look out for temporary signs that alert you to the presence of nesting birds or chicks.
- If you see little birds running swiftly along the beach or hear the larger oystercatchers calling out, please give these birds space. If it is spring or summer, chances are they have a nest or chicks nearby.
- Disturbance to these birds can be lethal, the perceived threat of unleashed dogs causing them to leave the eggs or hiding the chicks for dangerously long periods.



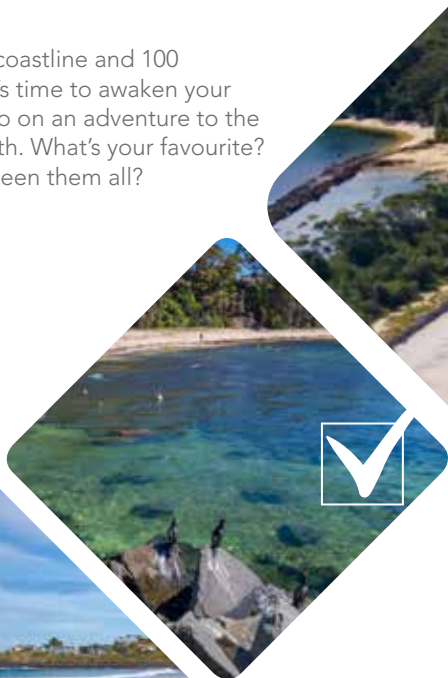

On-leash Dog Trails

Experience Shoalhaven's bushland, reserves and coastline with your best friend by your side.

BOMADERRY CREEK GORGE (from Narang Road, Bomaderry)

2-3 hrs Medium grade

Steps and ladder, features rock walls, narrow gorges, moist gully, wildlife.

BANGALEE RESERVE (from Koloona Drive, North Nowra)

2-3 hrs Easy/medium

All seasons, pioneer history, river views.

THE GROTTO (from Yurunga Drive, North Nowra)

1-4 hrs Medium grade

Many steps, rainforest, zigzag down 45 metres from cliff-tops to the banks of the Shoalhaven River.

BEN'S WALK (from Nowra Showground along Nowra creek)

1.5 hrs Easy grade

Many steps, cliffs, weir crossing, suspension bridge, history.

ABRAHAMS BOSOM (from Beecroft Parade, Currarong):

• **Wreck Walk**

1hr Easy grade

Wreck of S.S. Merimbula, flat terrain with few steep sections, firm ground or boardwalk, whale spotting.

• **Coomies Walk**

3 hrs Medium grade

Panoramic views, undulating terrain.

HUSKISSON TO PLANTATION POINT SHARED PATHWAY

2 hrs return Easy grade

Views of Jervis Bay, accessible pathway, watch for bikes.

WIRREECOO WALKING TRAIL & MANGROVE BOARDWALK

(from Jervis Bay Maritime Museum, Huskisson)

1-2 hrs Easy grade

Boardwalk, estuarine wetlands, forest, history.

BASIN FORESHORE WALK (Sanctuary Point/St Georges Basin),

1-4 hrs Easy grade

Best late in the day, birdlife, lighting on lake, café,

Dogs must avoid Palm Beach and Red Head.

CORRAMY REGIONAL PARK (from Wool Road, Basin View)

1-2 hrs Easy grade

Forest, wetland, boardwalk, fishing, birdwatching. Use trails only.

BENDALONG BOAT HARBOUR AND HEADLAND

1.5 hrs Easy grade

All seasons, views, cliffs, beaches, stingrays, café.

ULLADULLA HARBOUR, HEADLAND AND MILLARDS CREEK

(including One Track for All Aboriginal Cultural Trail)

2.5 hrs Easy grade

All seasons, aboriginal artwork, views, creek, café.

WARDEN HEAD (from Deering Street)

including the Coomee Nulunga Cultural Trail

2.5hrs Medium grade

Tide affected, fossils, lighthouse, whale-watching, cultural sculptures.

ULLADULLA WILDFLOWER RESERVE NATURE WALK (from Green St)

<1hr Easy grade

Woodland, wildflowers.

BOARDWALK TO CONJOLA BEACH (from Lake Conjola Entrance Road)

<1hr Easy grade

Beach and lake views. Dogs are prohibited near endangered shorebird nesting site on sandspit north of boardwalk.

Camping & Dogs

Getting away from it all and sleeping in the outdoors is a popular Shoalhaven activity with so many unspoilt spots. What could be better than having your dog along too?

Spending time together outdoors is one of the greatest things you can do with your dog. Camping offers fresh air, exercise and the opportunity to bond, as well as learning experiences provided by new and challenging environments. With time and patience your dog can become the ultimate outdoor companion. Here are some tips to help you enjoy the great outdoors:

- Check with each park before you make a booking as some parks may have changed their dog friendly policy.
- It is your responsibility to clean up after your dog so be sure to bring some small plastic bags and take the waste home with you.
- Training can be important for your dog's safety if you are venturing into bushland. Make sure your dog comes when called. The command "leave it" could save your dog from a snake or fox bait. Use lots of rewards and positive reinforcement.
- Remember to carry water for your dog and a collapsible water bowl. Dogs can't sweat so they need to drink to stay cool.
- A clip on LED light for your dog's collar will allow you to find him in the dark and allow others to see him too.
- A tether, carrier, crate or portable fencing can help to confine your dog.
- A dog coat may be needed for cold nights.
- A muzzle can be useful to prevent your dog eating found items.

Shoalhaven's beautiful bush-land and nature trails as well as a range of facilities provide some great opportunities for holidaying with your horse.

Shoalhaven offers opportunities to ride and camp with your horse in beautiful bush landscapes. Swimming your horse in lakes and rivers, riding trails through rugged mountains with breathtaking escarpment views, or exploring dense hinterland forests.

For those that want to experience the region on horseback but don't have their own equine buddy, there are several venues where you can take a trail ride with panoramic views, through lush rainforest, rich farmland, and across creeks and rivers.

Holiday riding camps for children are available, as well as corporate rides designed to reward, challenge and motivate your team. It is even possible to hire beautiful horses for your fairytale wedding here in the Shoalhaven.

Cat Hotels

Cats can be nervous travellers, but with planning, stress to you and your kitty can be kept to a minimum.

When travelling by car, your cat should be kept in their carrier at all times, for your safety and theirs. Most cats will curl up and sleep after a period of meowing. Provide a familiar bed or towel so that your cat feels safe and secure in its carrier. Talk calmly to your cat, and avoid loud music.

Book your and your cat's accommodation ahead of time. Always double-check your hotel's pet friendly policy at the time of booking.

When you arrive at your hotel, check for potential dangers to your cat, such as holes, mouse traps, cupboards or open windows, before opening the carrier. Restrict your cat to one small room, or consider bringing a collapsible pet tent to help them adjust to new surroundings and ensure you won't spend your holiday searching for a runaway pet.

Use your best hotel etiquette by ensuring cleanliness with food bowls and litter trays, and avoid damage to furniture from scratching claws. A 'do not disturb' sign can prevent unnecessary opening of the door.

You may decide it would be less stressful for your cat to stay in one of the Shoalhaven's pet holiday facilities. Many offer tranquil, home-like environments with classical music, television, private courtyards or sun decks, heating, scratching posts, plush bedding and lounge suites. Purr-fect.

Plan ahead and keep calm, and you and your cat can enjoy travelling together.

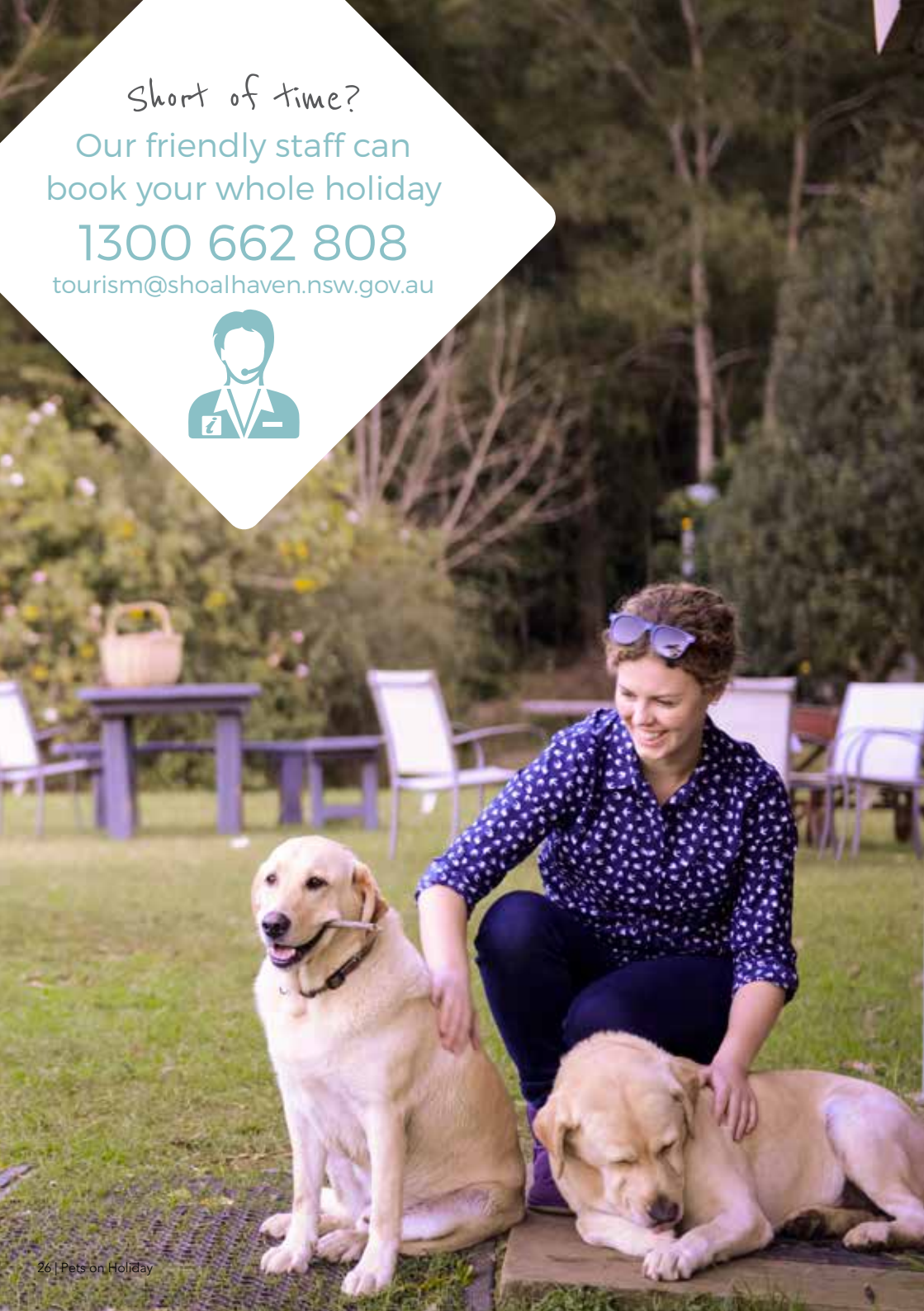

Pet Friendly Retail

Many cafes, markets and stores in the Shoalhaven welcome pets. Shopping and dining with your dog can be an integral part of your holiday experience.

It can also be a bonding experience, and help socialise your dog while boosting his or her confidence. A well-behaved dog in a store or cafe can also be a great ambassador for their species or breed.

Businesses welcome pets at their discretion, so it is important to insure your dog's behaviour is suited to the venue. Ensure your dog is on a leash, will not bark, and will follow commands such as "sit" and "stay". Take along a water bowl, water bottle, snacks and treats. Also carry plenty of bags so you can pick up after your dog. Only allow your dog to socialise with people or other dogs once invited.

Your dog may be very nervous or excited by the shopping or cafe environment. Take him or her for a good long walk before hand. If needed, sit quietly with your dog and allow some time to adjust to the sounds and smells. Keep your dog close to you, not in the path of shoppers or waiters. Reward your dog for good behaviour. Watch for signs or stress and be prepared to leave if necessary.

Dogs love exploring new places with the person they love most, they'll receive attention, hugs, and smiles from many people. People around will enjoy seeing a wagging tail, and it may even be the bright spot that makes their day. And after a fun day with your best friend, you'll have a tired, happy dog and hopefully some new goodies too!
